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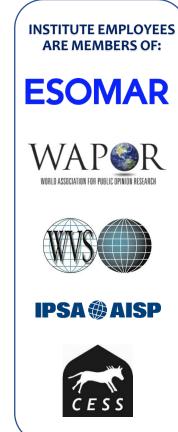

WORLD VALUES SURVEY



WVS is an international project that studies the cultural and value orientations of society. The study was initiated by the American sociologist Ronald Inglehart and has been conducted since 1981. From 1981 to 2021, 7 waves of research were conducted in more than 90 countries. The main goal of the project is to study changes in the people's worldview, their value orientations and attitudes towards various aspects of life.

Since 2017, the 7th wave of research has started, in which, since 2018, Public Opinion Research Institute is a representative of Kazakhstan.

Since 2018 Botagoz Rakisheva, PhD, Project Director of the Institute, is the Principal investigator of WVS-7 in Kazakhstan.

In 2021, the Institute team conducted a study of the Eurasian Barometer in **Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan** commissioned by the Eurasian Barometer. The survey was conducted among citizens of Kazakhstan over 18 years of age. Sample of 1200 respondents

The Eurasian Barometer is a non-profit, non-governmental, international research organization headquartered in Vienna, Austria. The main goal is to monitor political, social and economic transformations in the countries of post-communist Europe and post-Soviet Eurasia.

Founders: Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Türkiye.

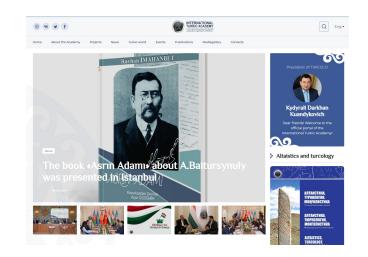

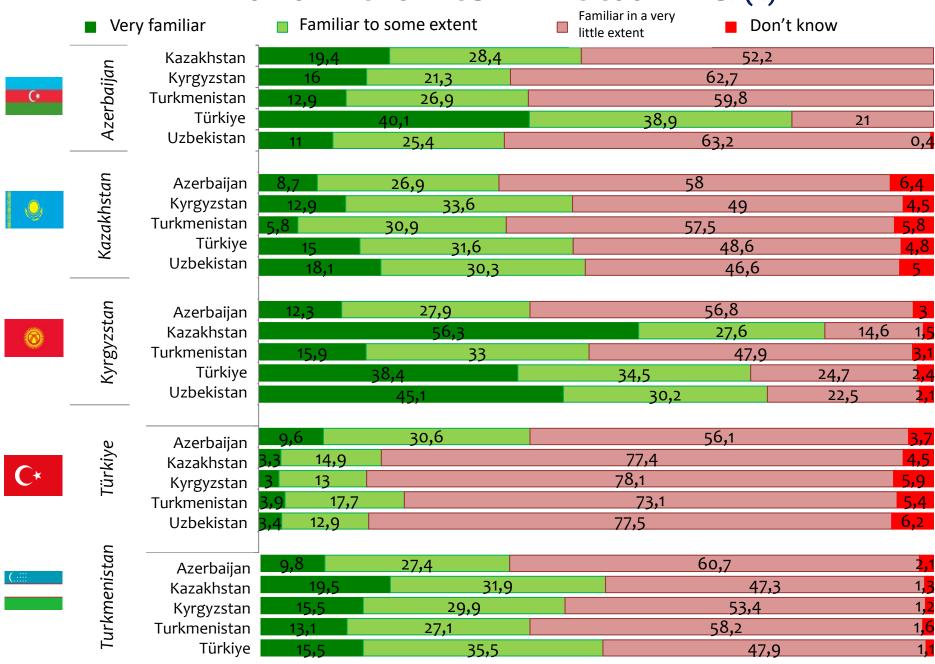

- \checkmark study international organizations of Turkic-speaking states.

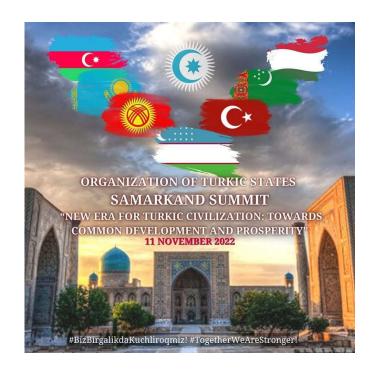
