# SAMPLING AND METHODOLOGY

The survey was conducted by NAMA Strategic Intelligence Solutions.

NAMA Is licensed by the Jordan Media Commission, the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, and the Investment Commission to conduct surveys all around Jordan at all times.

This survey was conducted through Computer-assisted telephone interviews “CATI”, conducted nationwide in Jordan, throughout the period between the 7<sup>th</sup> of March and the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 2022.

The original sample size consisted of 1,637 respondents covering the whole country, of which 81.1% (1328 respondents) accepted to proceed with the interview. Of those who accepted, 93.5% (1,241 respondents) heard about the Russian-Ukrainian crisis.

The final completed sample size was 1,241 respondents covering the whole country.

For the purpose of this study, Jordanians aged 18 year and above were the targeted group. NAMA used its nationally representative list of geographically distributed phone numbers from its extensive phone directory. The frame provides information on the governorate, age, gender, education level.

# SAMPLING AND METHODOLOGY

This sample was designed to provide valid and reliable survey estimates across the entire Kingdom of Jordan including rural and urban areas, each of the twelve governorates, and smaller communities within.

The sample was also designed to ensure reliable estimates on regional levels (North, Center, and South).

Jordan's regions were grouped from governorates as follows: North (covering Ajloun, Irbid, Jerash, and Ma'raq), Central (covering Amman, Balqa, Madaba, and Zarqa), and South (covering Aqaba, Karak, Ma'an, and Tafieleh).

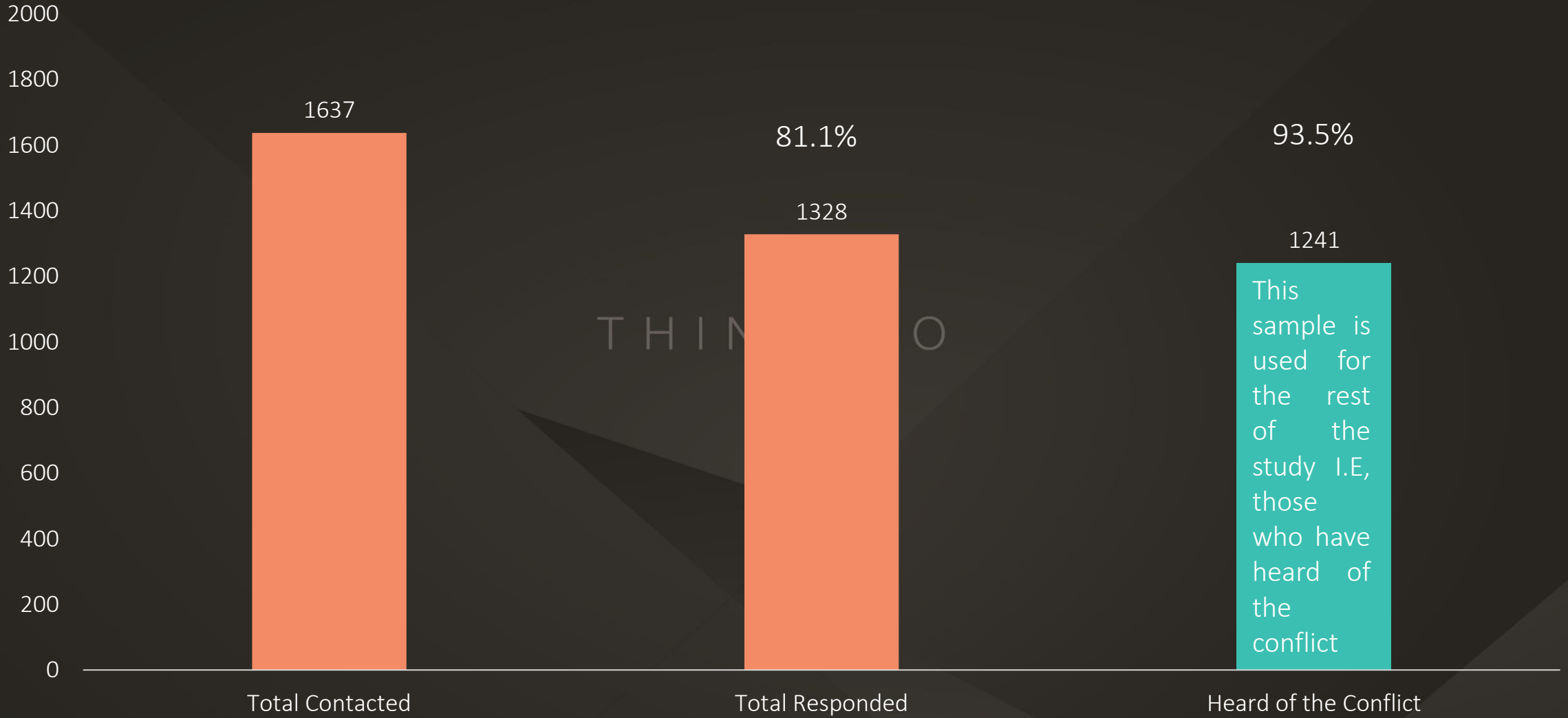
# SAMPLING AND METHODOLOGY

The objectives of this study stipulated that these respondents were Jordanian and aged 18 years or above. A team consisting of 11 enumerators and one supervisor conducted and monitored interviews.

A team of analysts and statisticians from NAMA have analyzed the data. The data was weighted to reflect the actual distribution of the population, the weight used the population size for each stratum and the block size (number of families) as main variables, also, the number of respondents from each block and the total number of block.

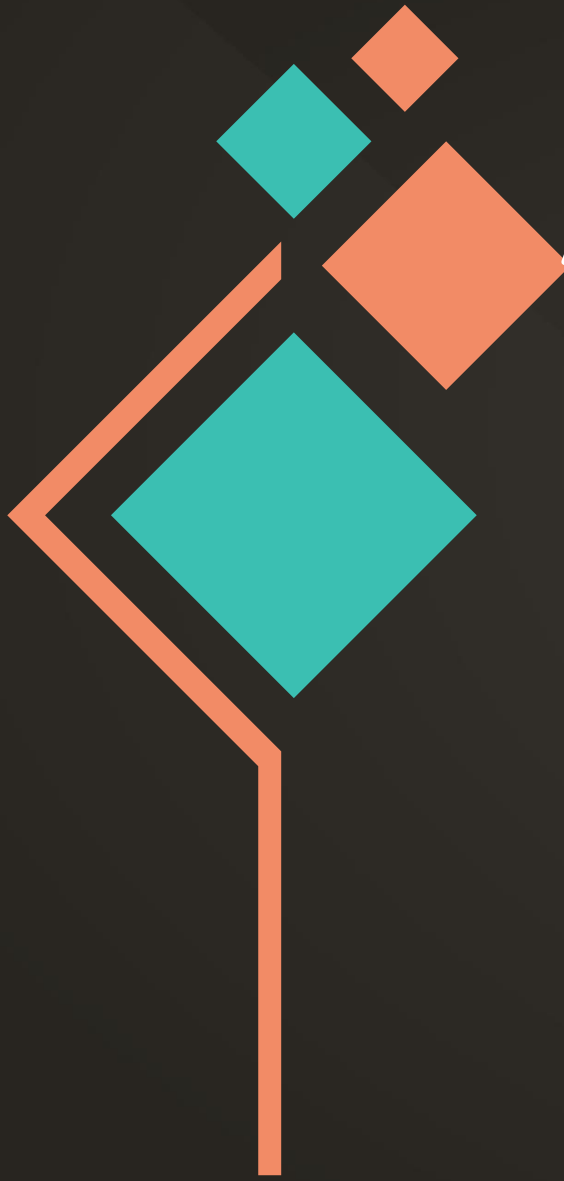

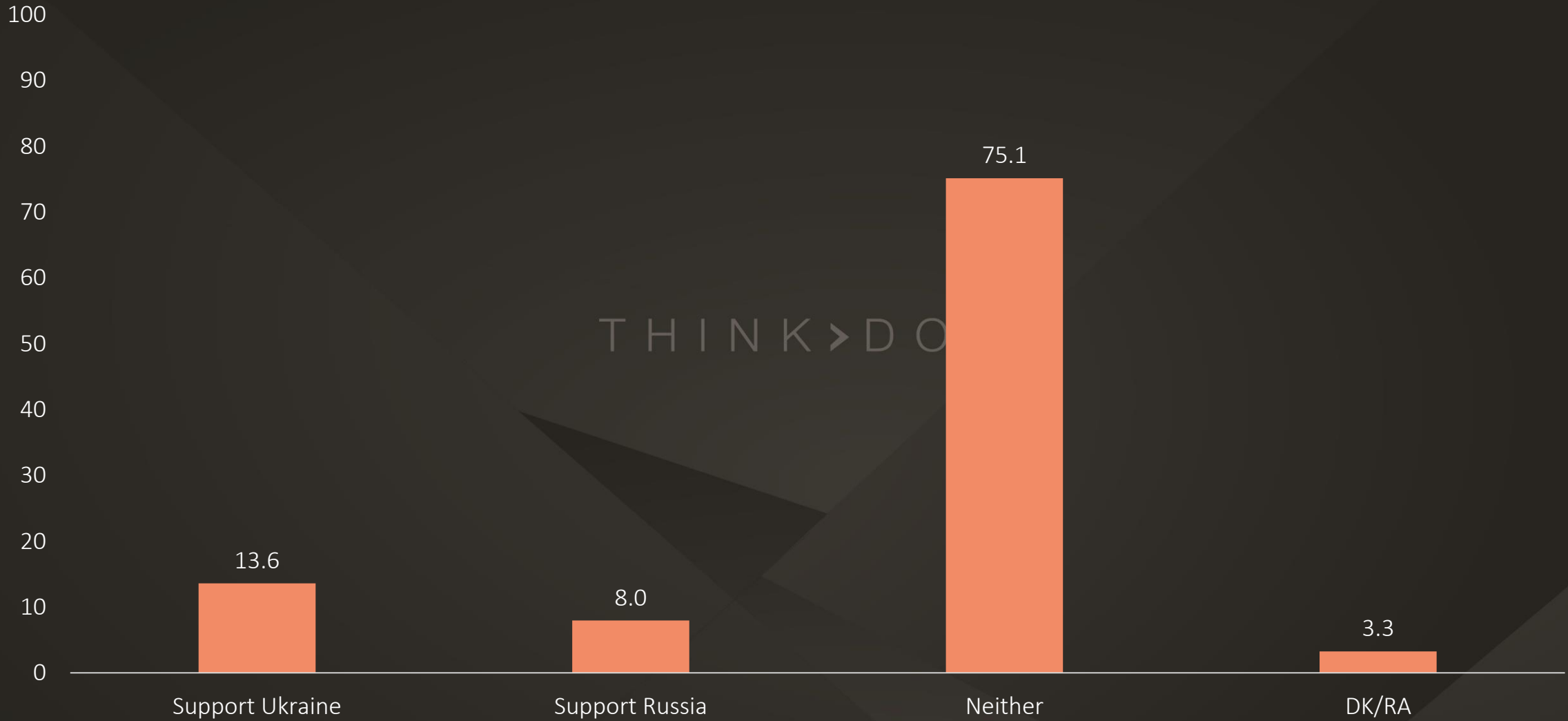

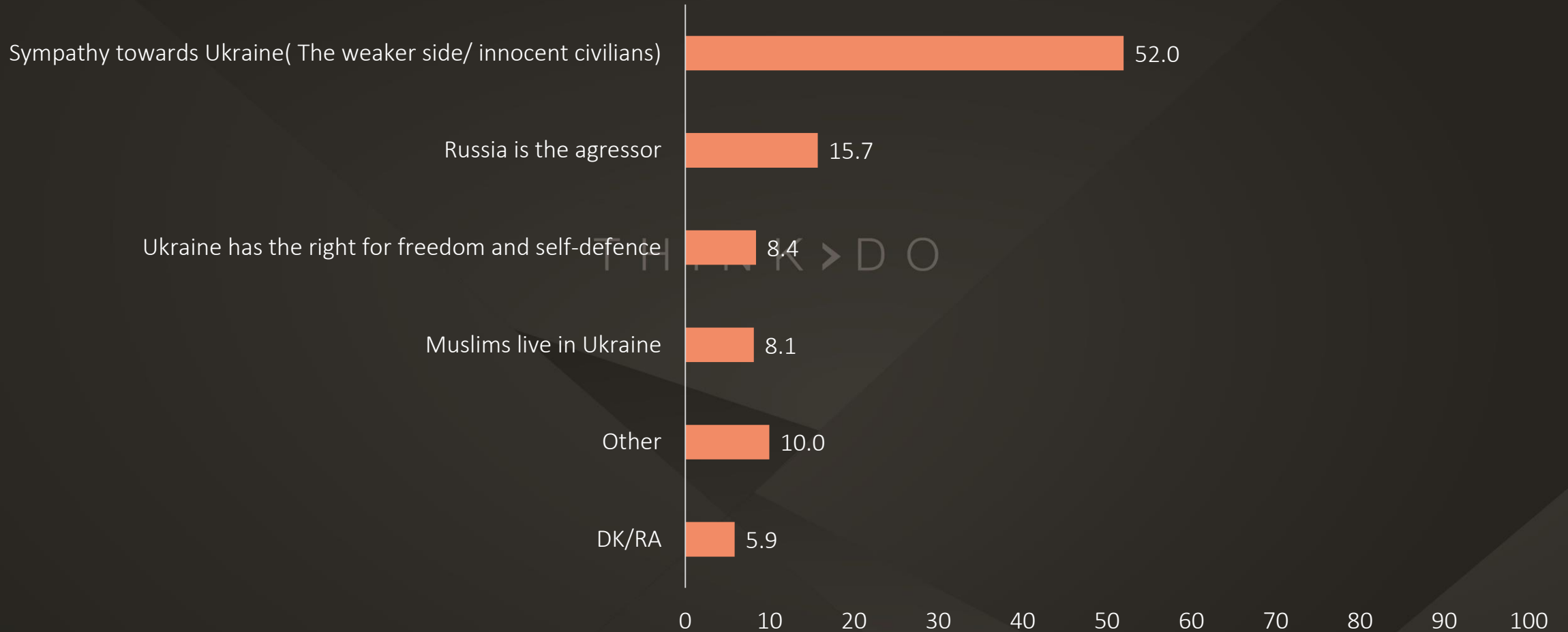
## In the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine, who do you support?

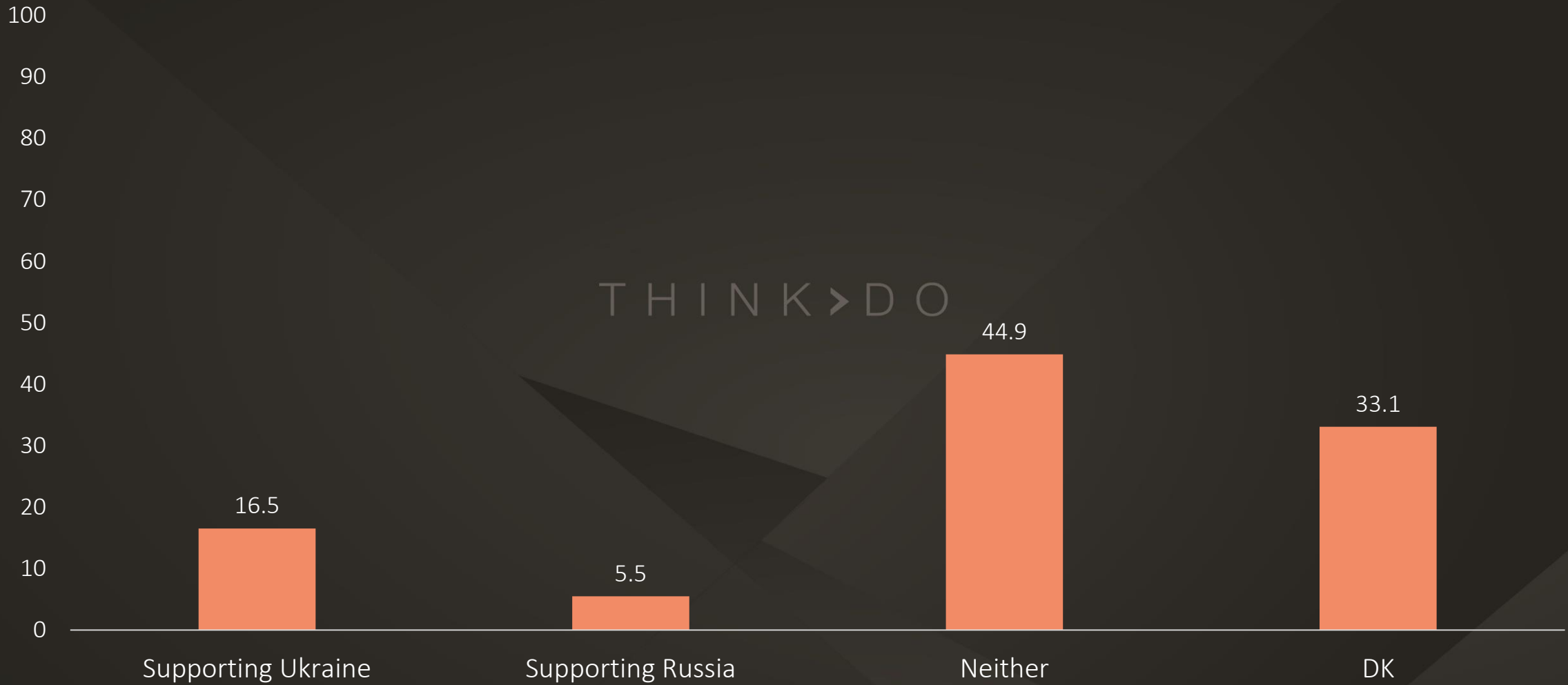


Why do you support Russia?

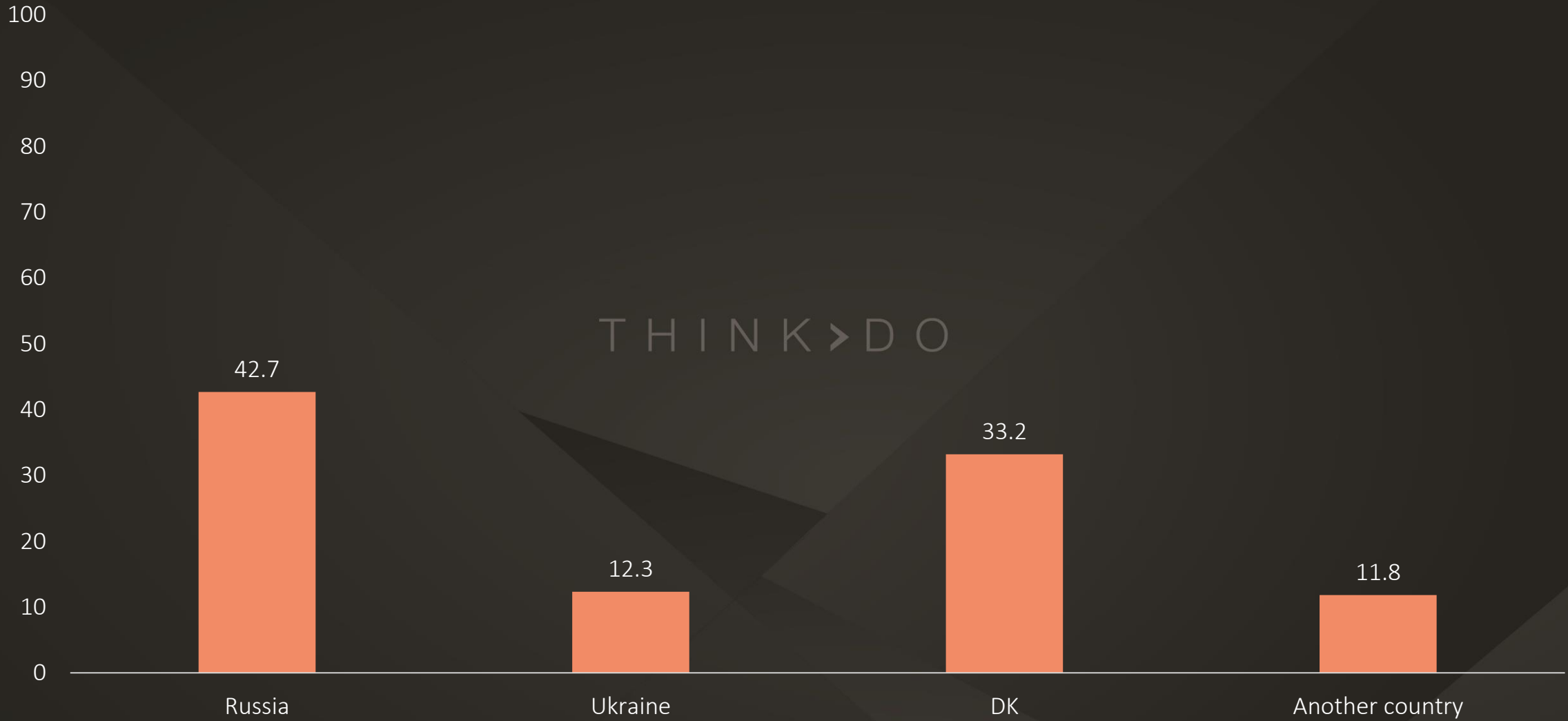

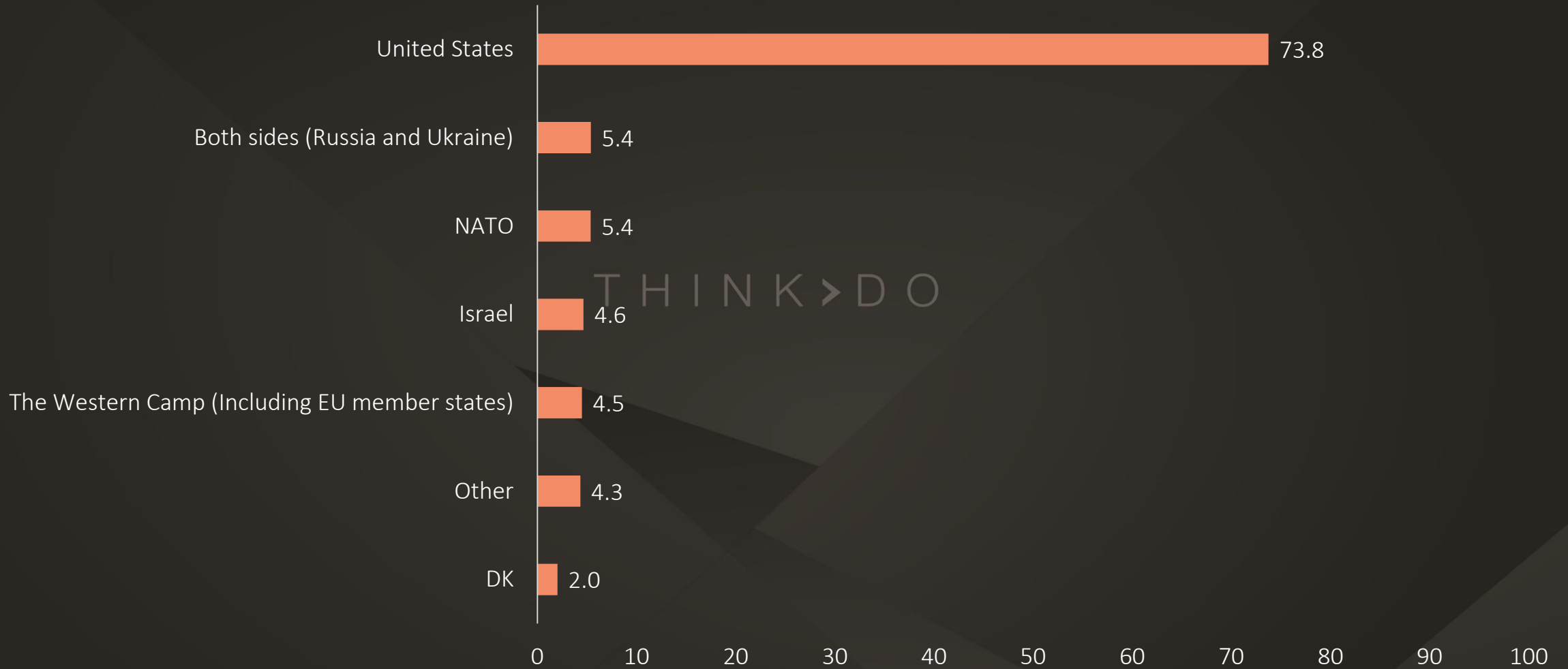
In the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine, which country do you think Jordan is supporting:

### In your view, who is responsible for the crisis?

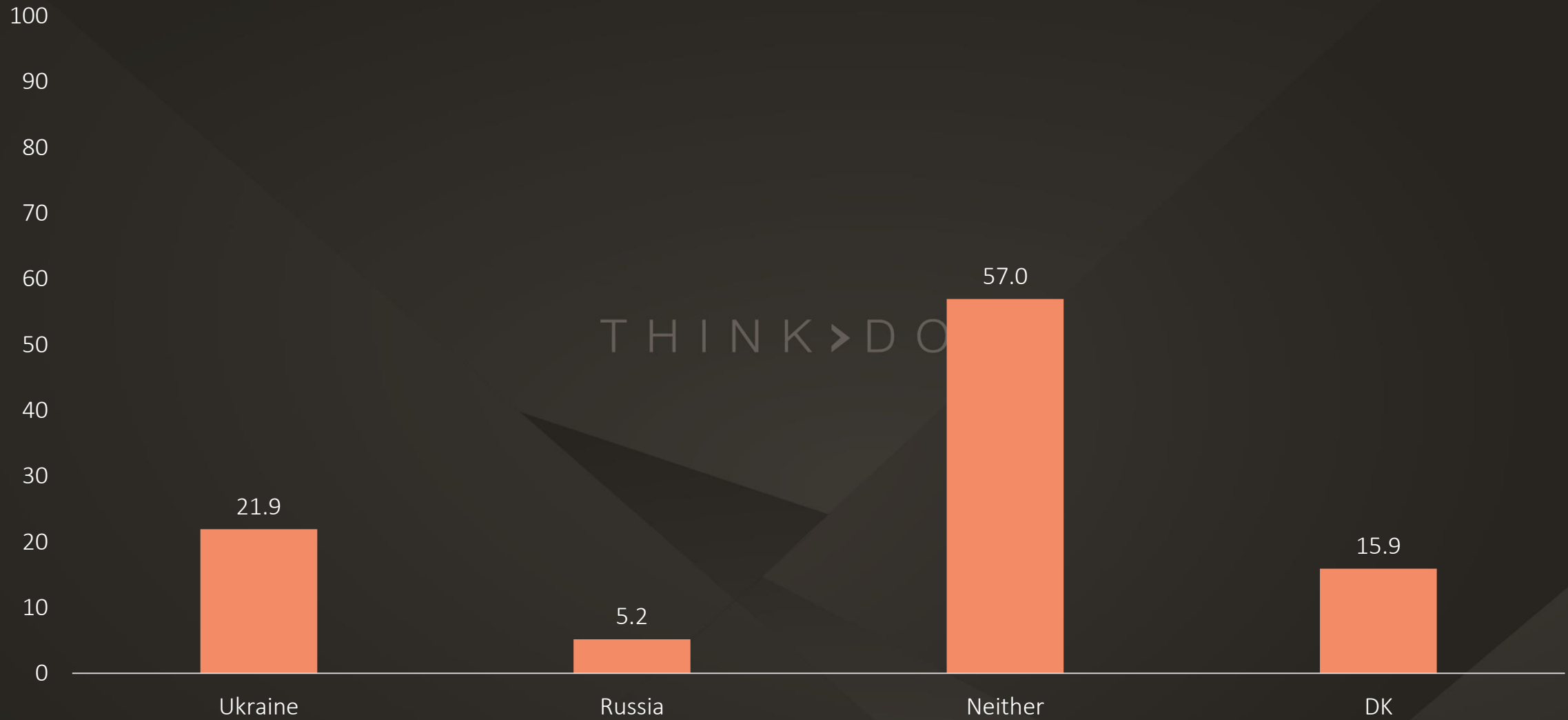

## Should Arab countries support Ukraine or Russia?



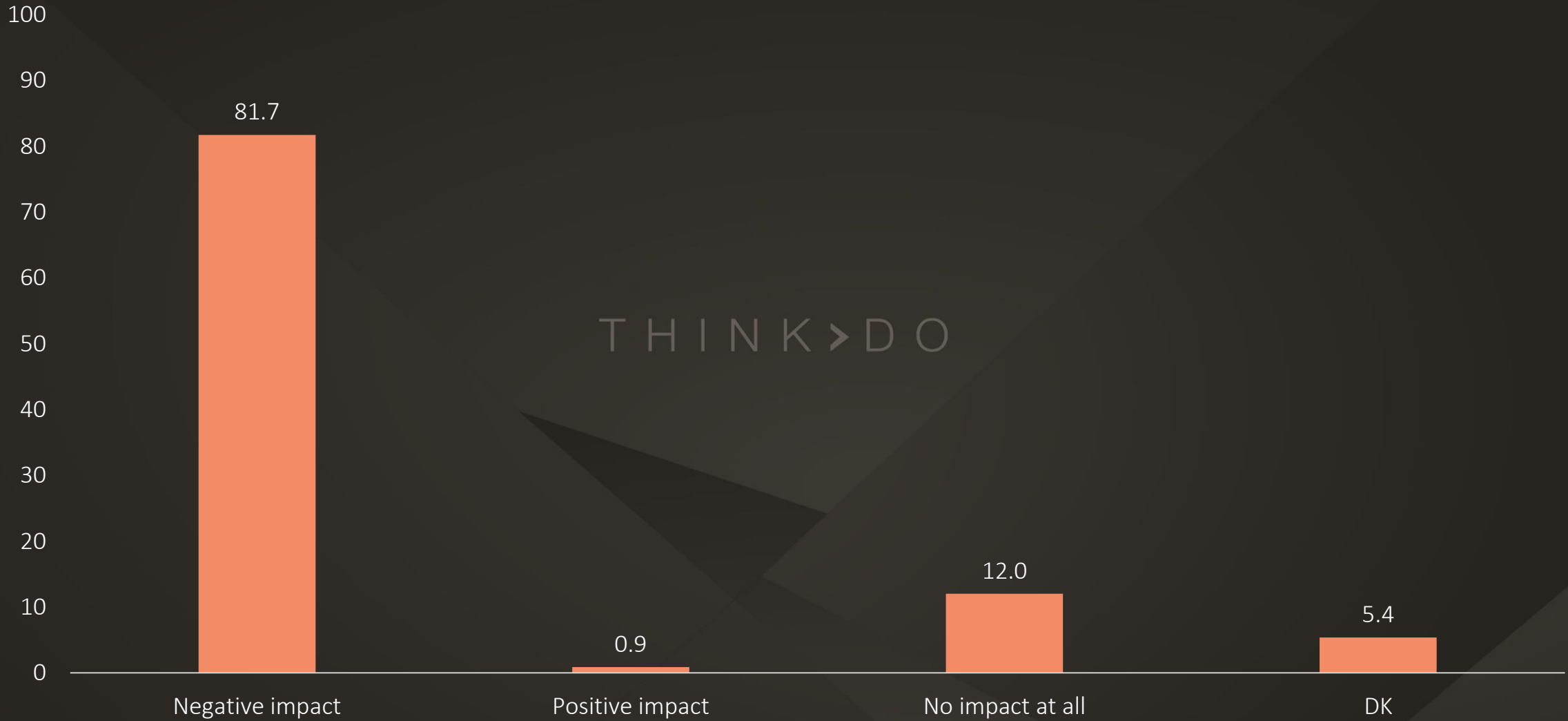

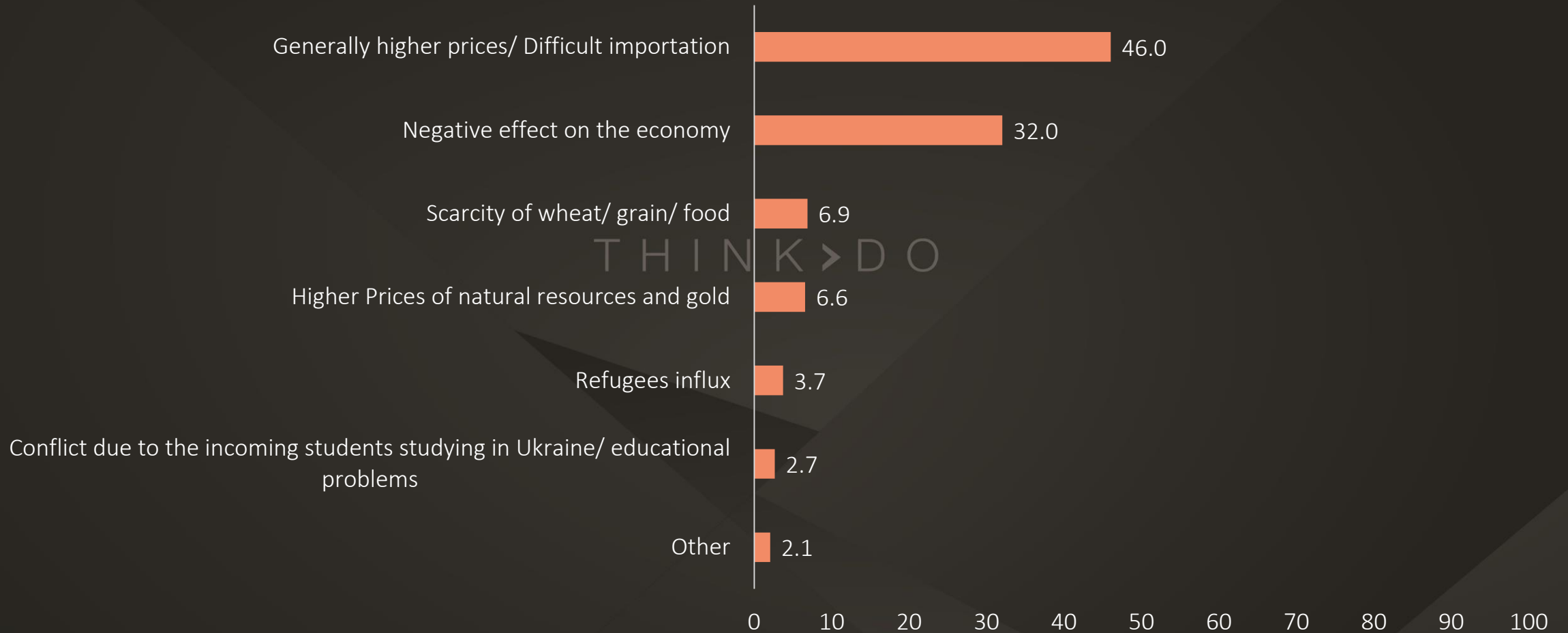
In your view, will this crisis have a positive or negative impact on Jordan?

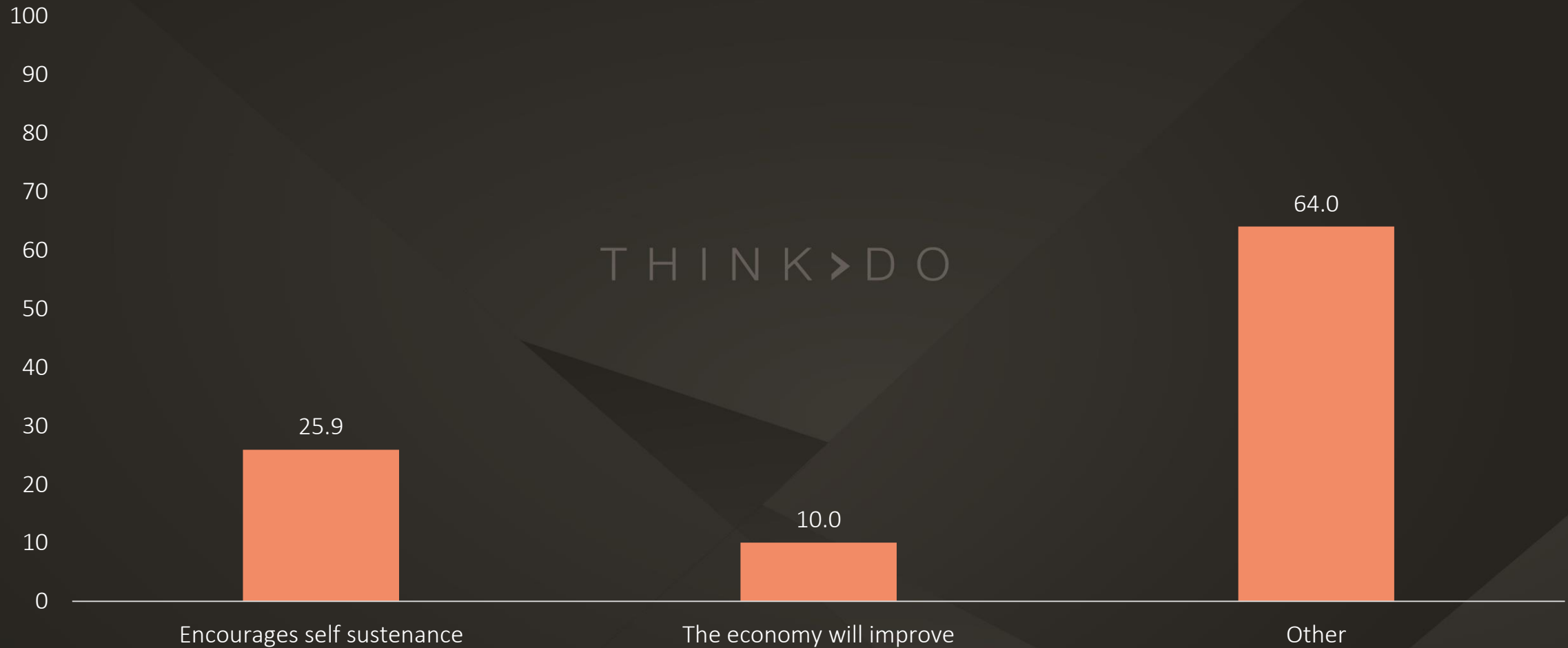

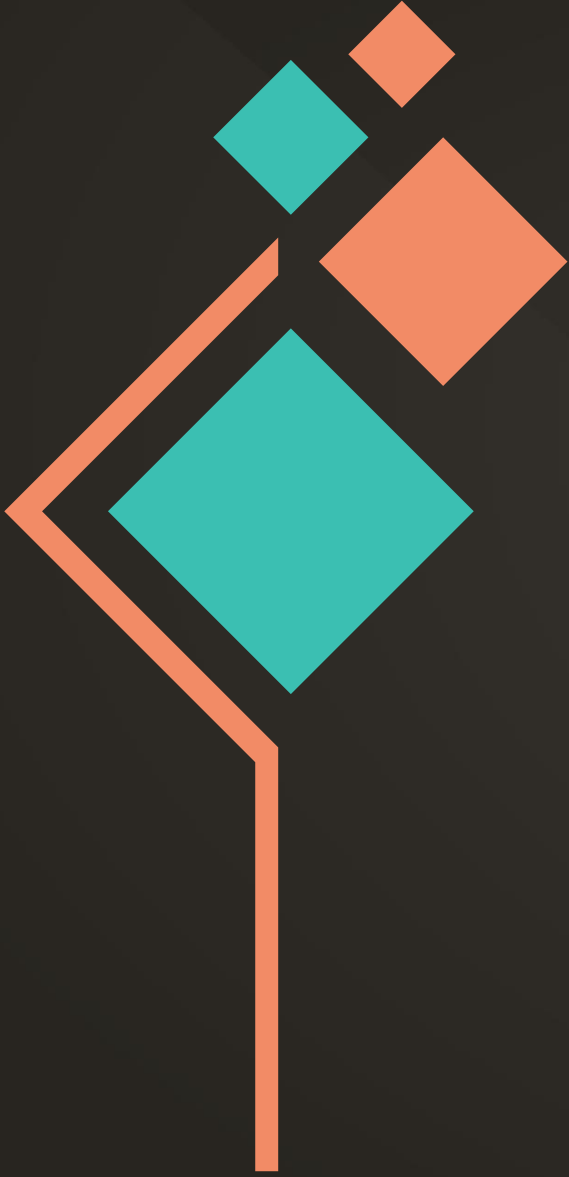

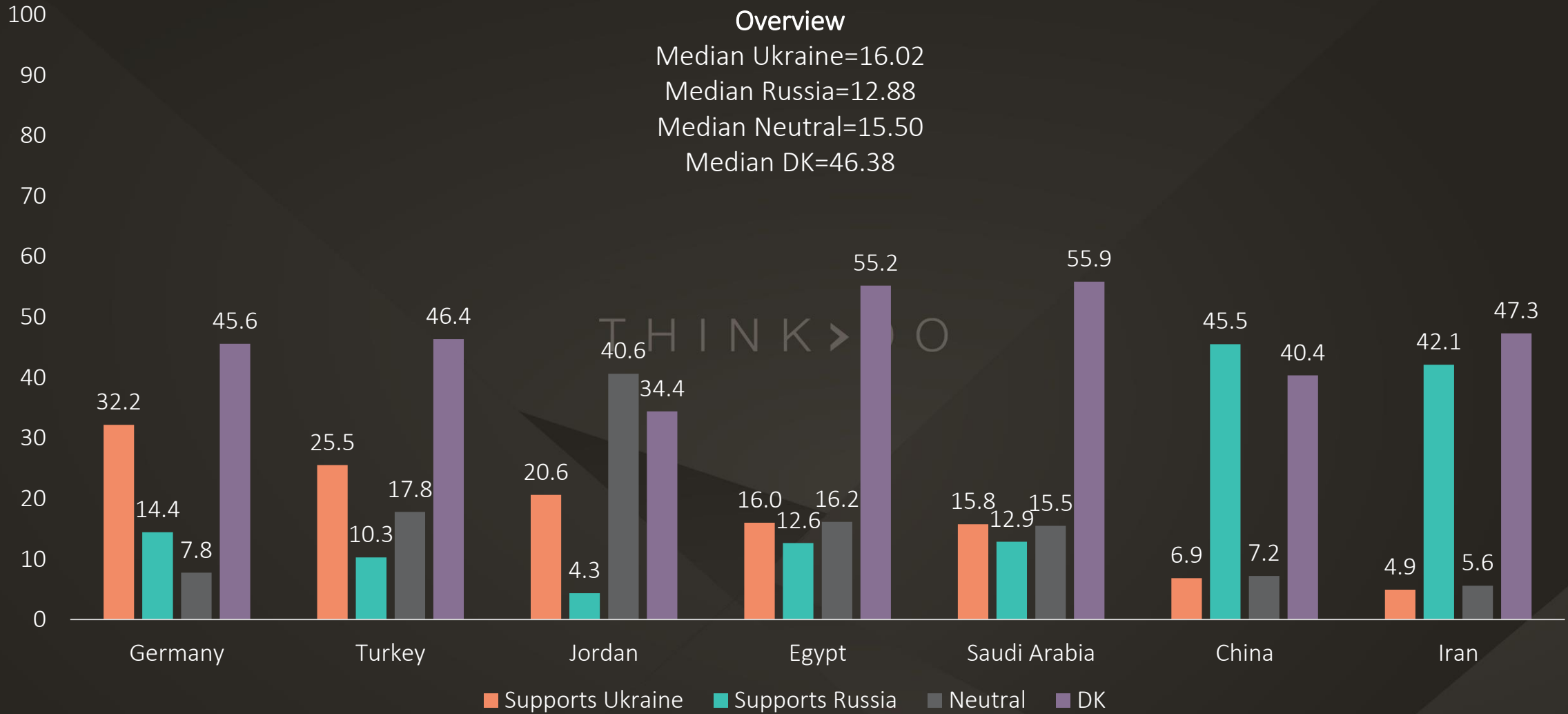

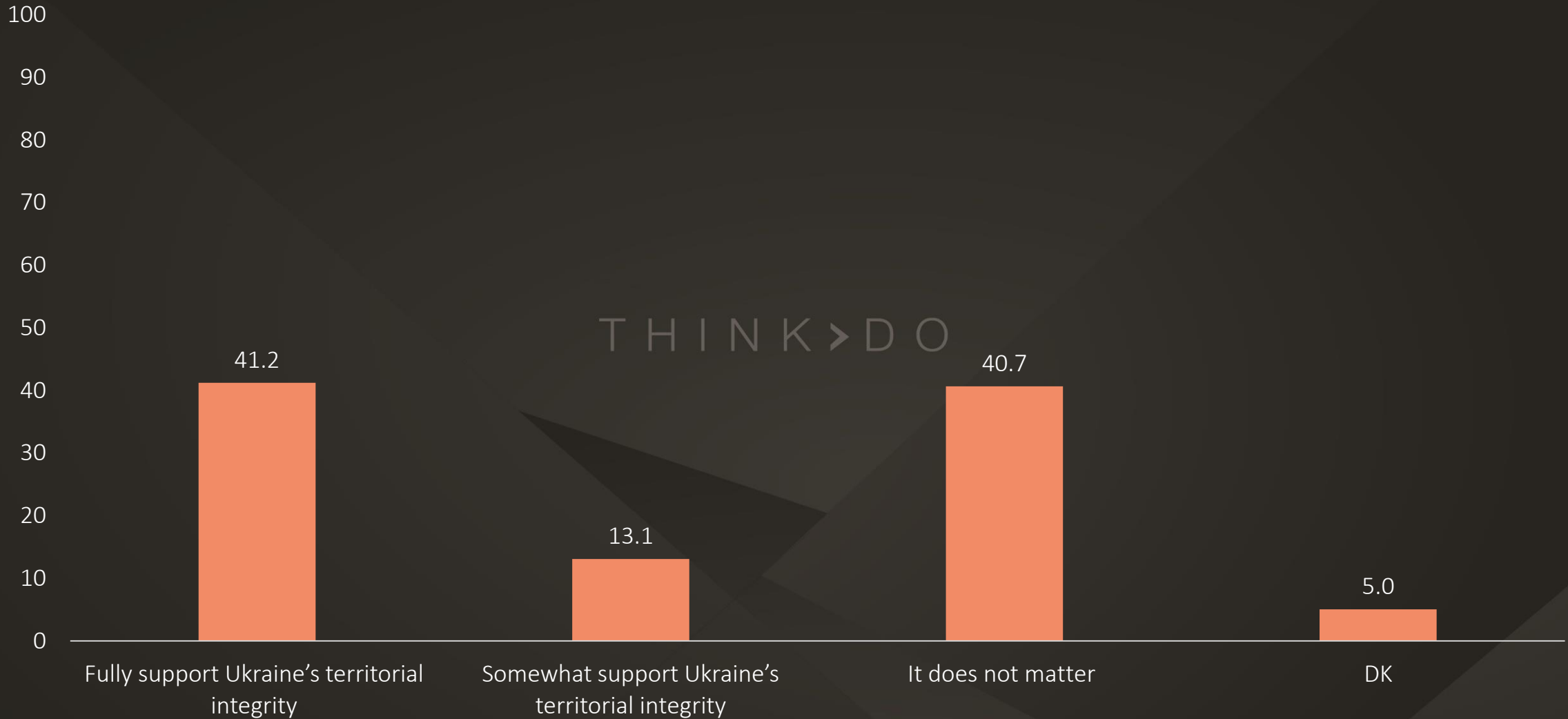

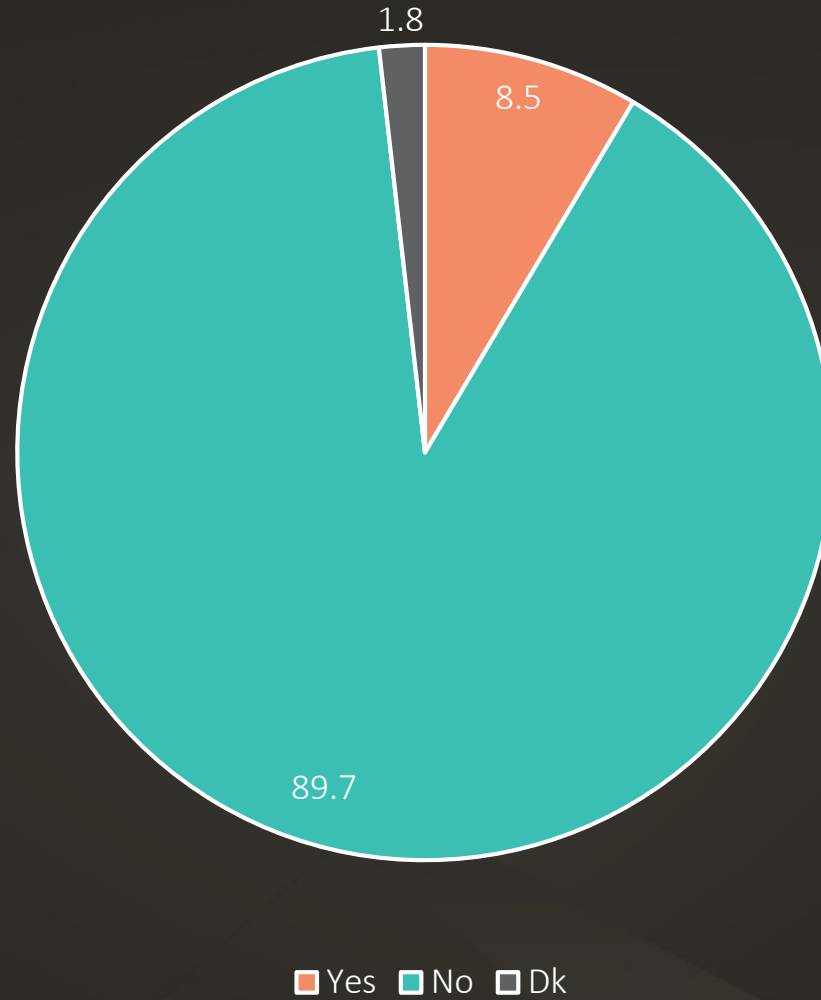

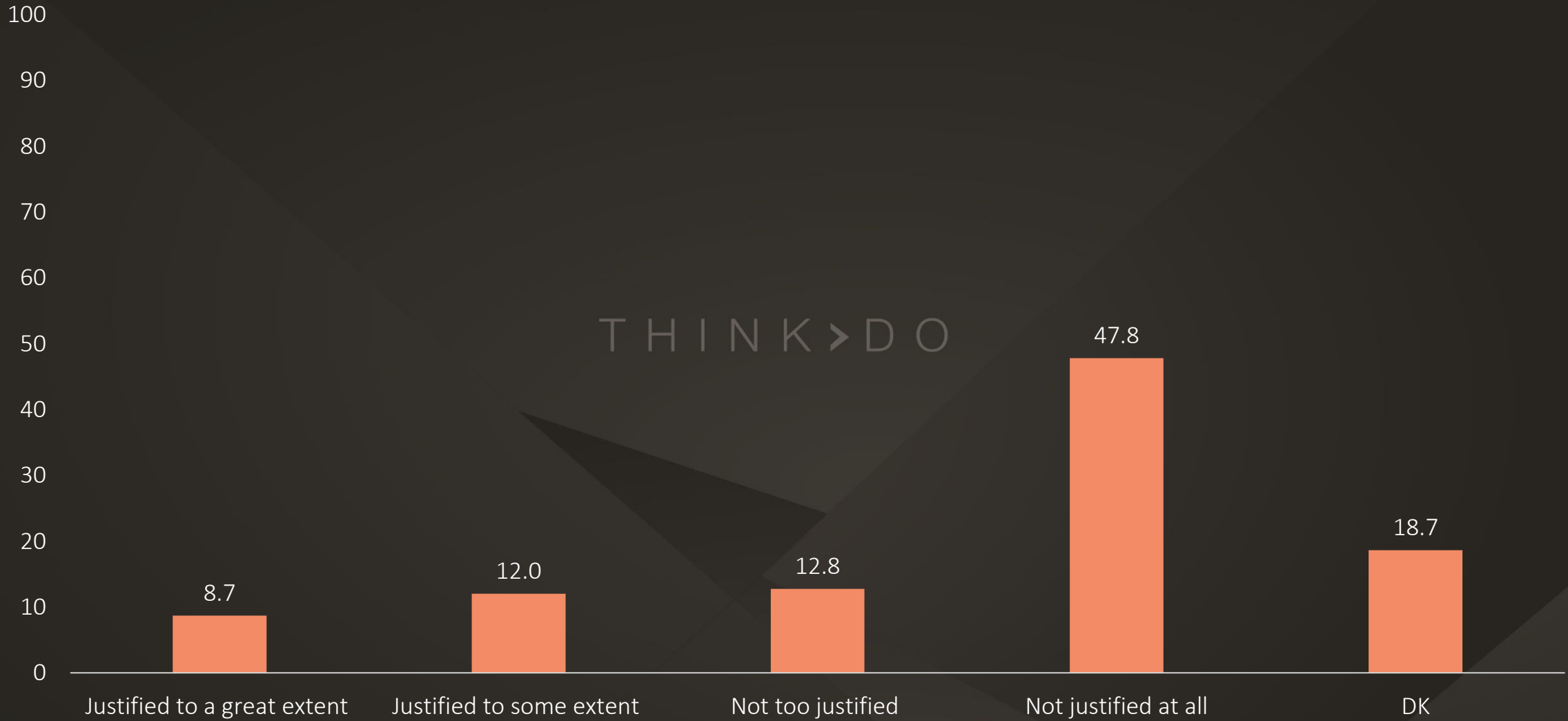
## Do you personally support the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine?



In principle, from your perspective, is it ever acceptable for a country to invade another country?

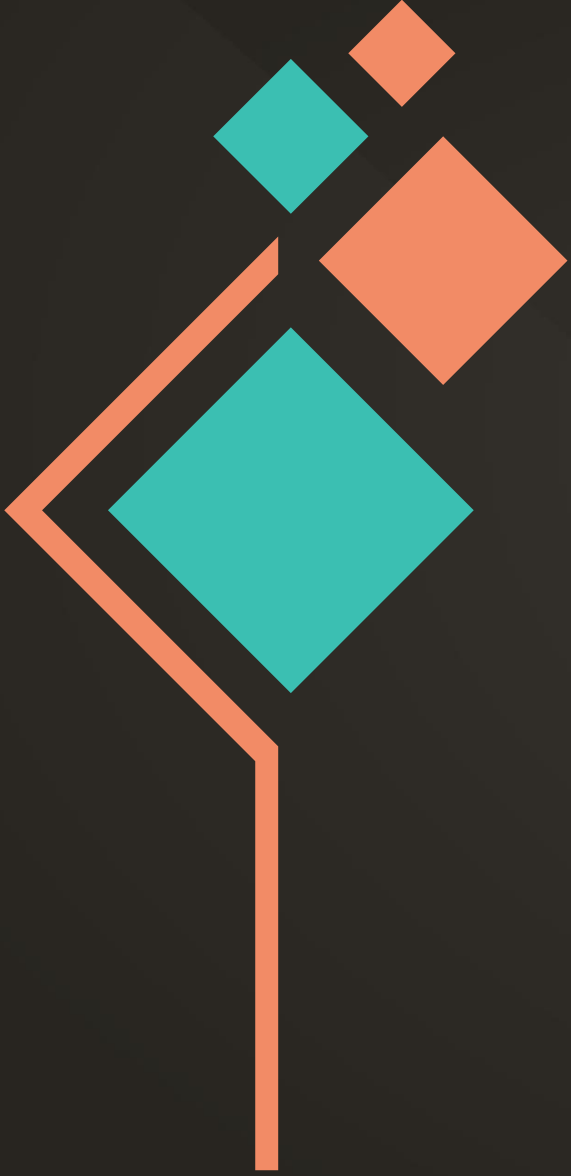


### To what extent do you think Russia's military invasion of Ukraine was justified or unjustified?



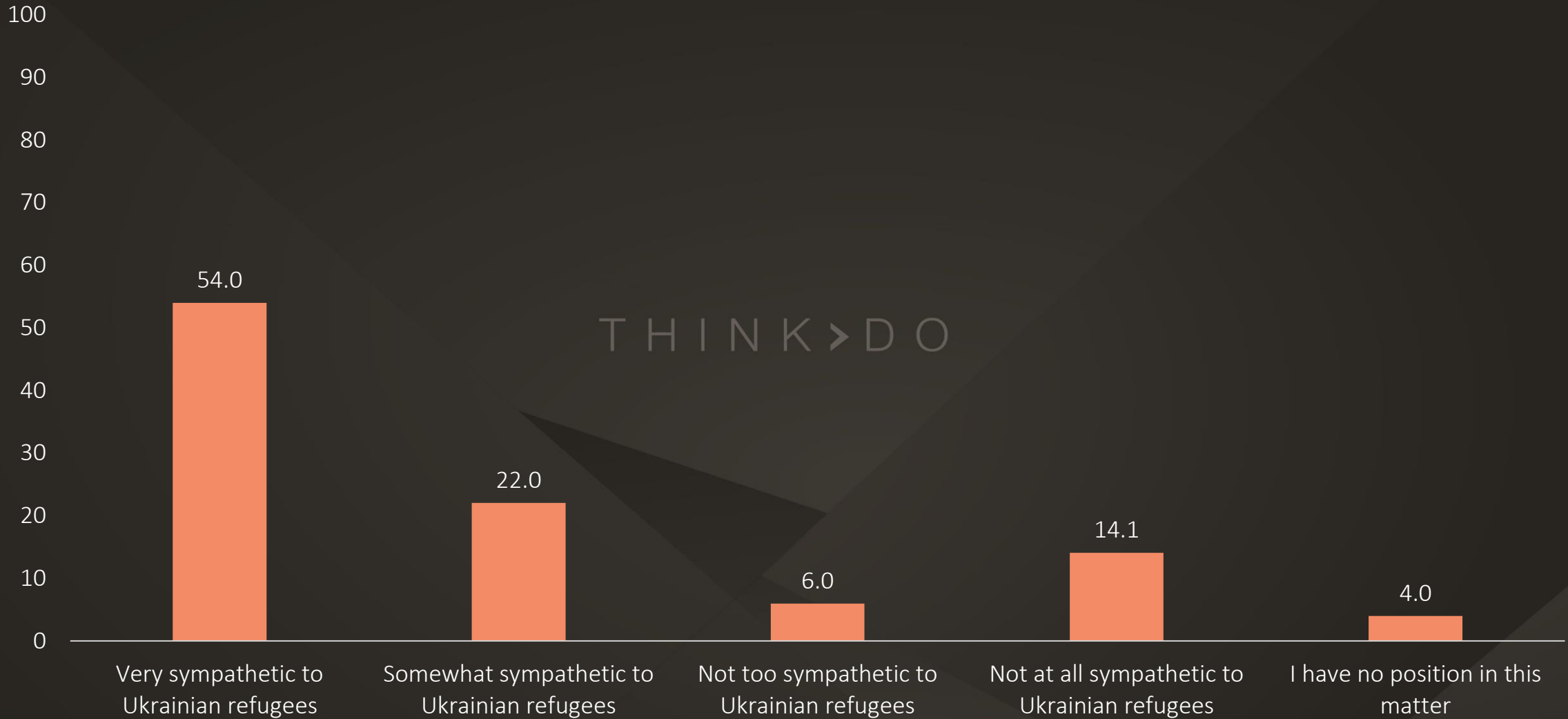

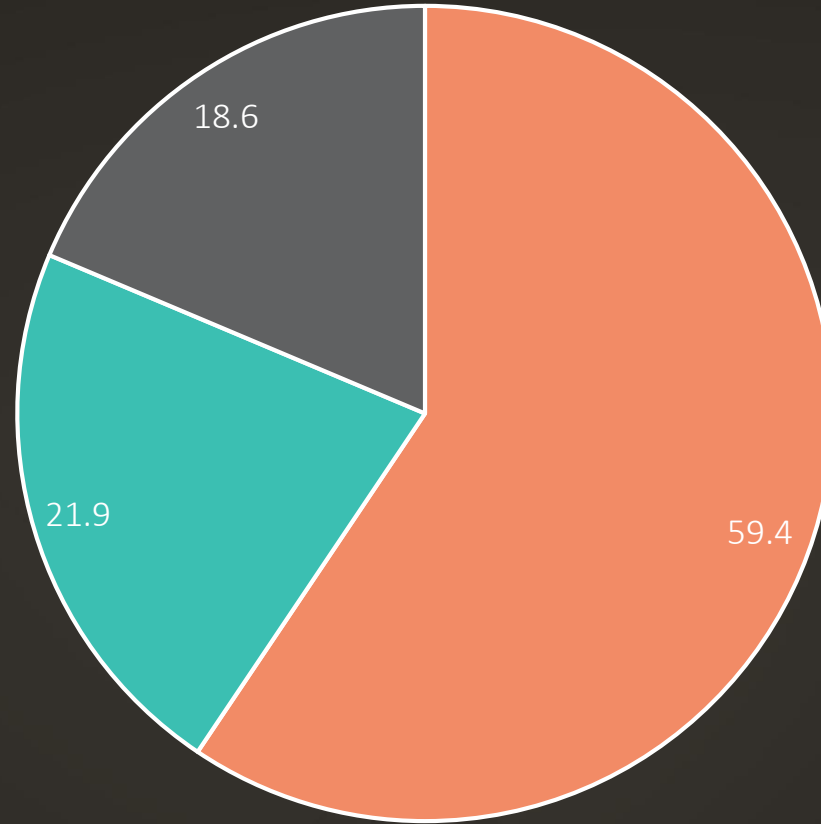




## How do you feel about the refugee crisis that the Russian invasion of Ukraine has created?



Do you think European countries are doing enough to take care of the Ukrainian refugees



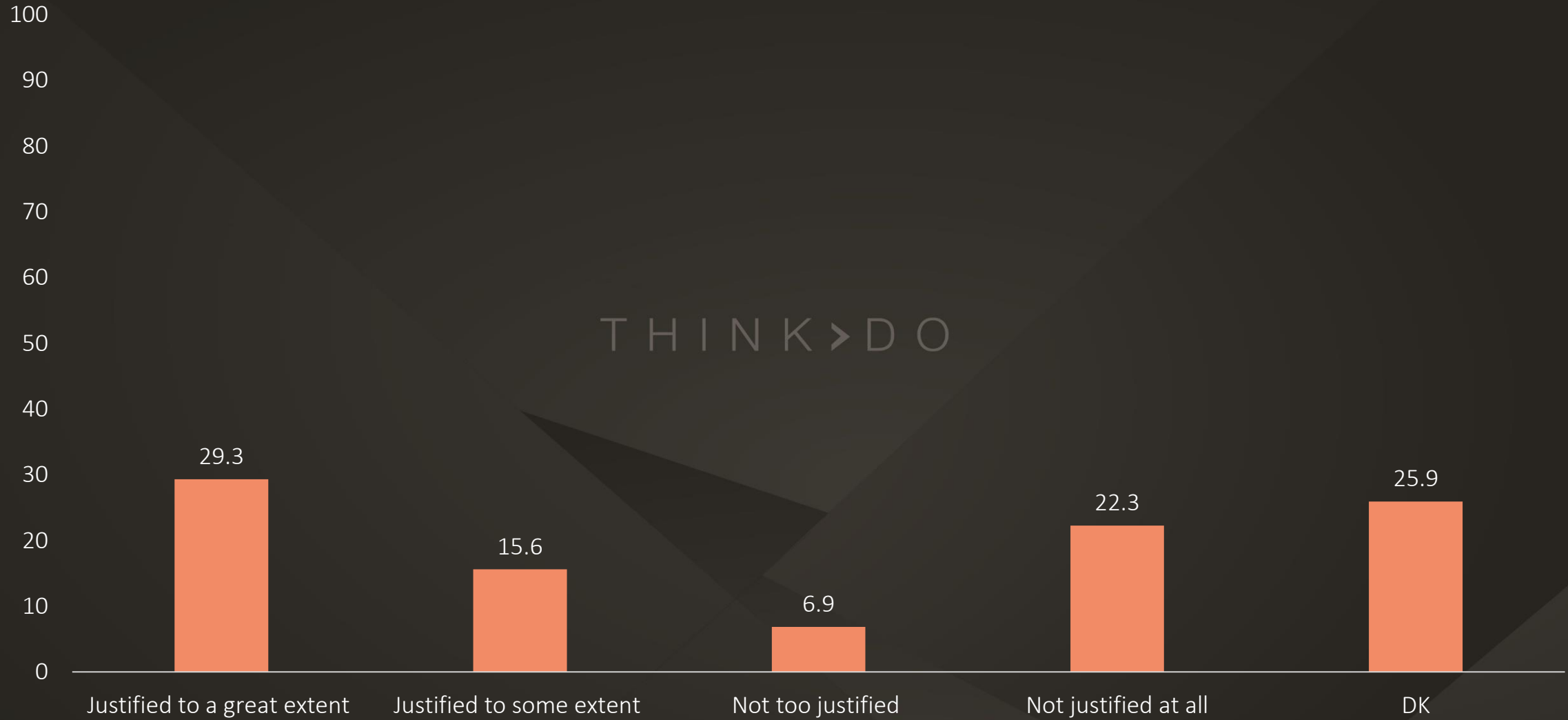

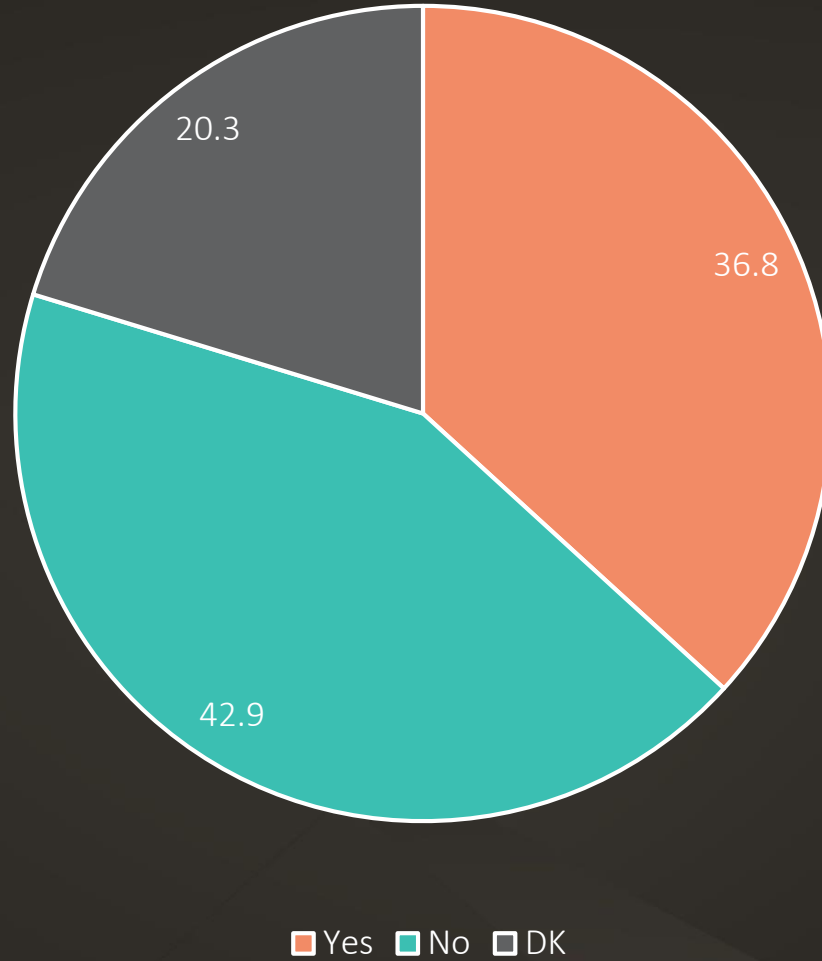

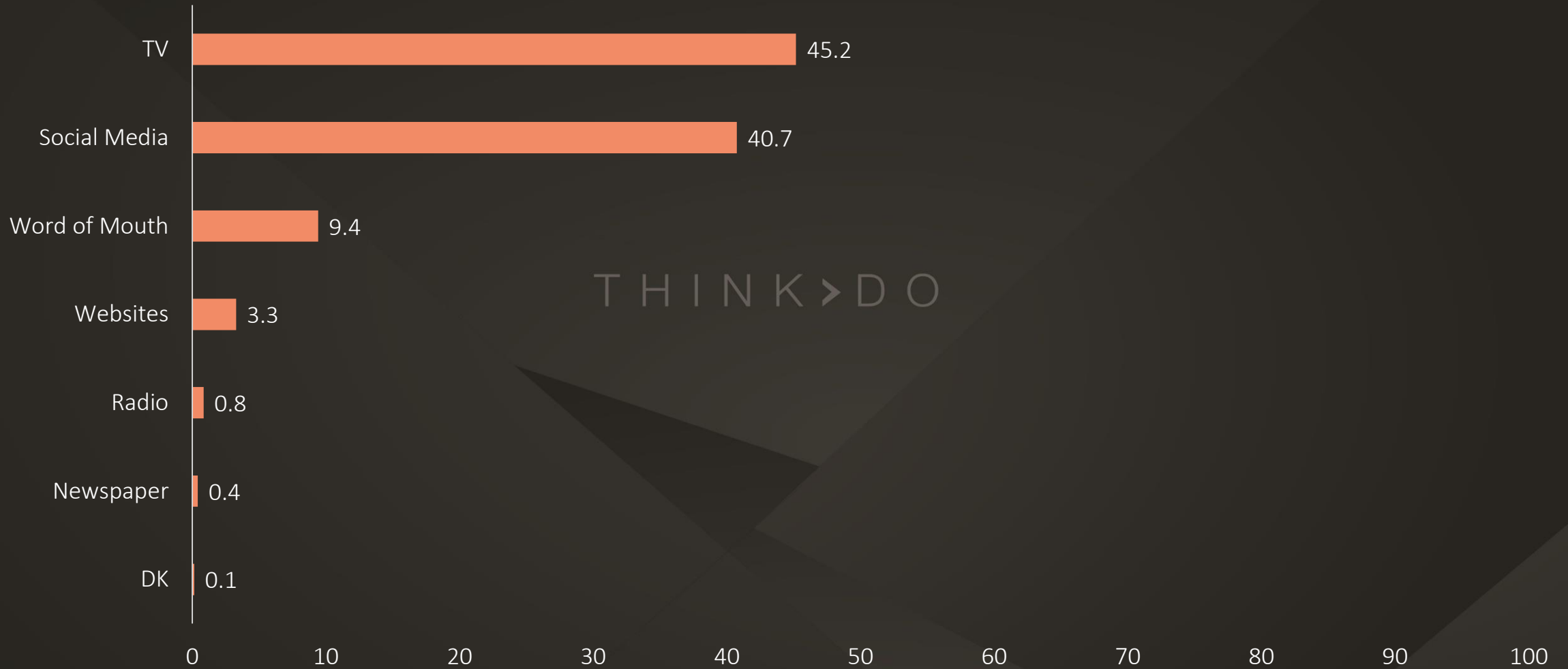

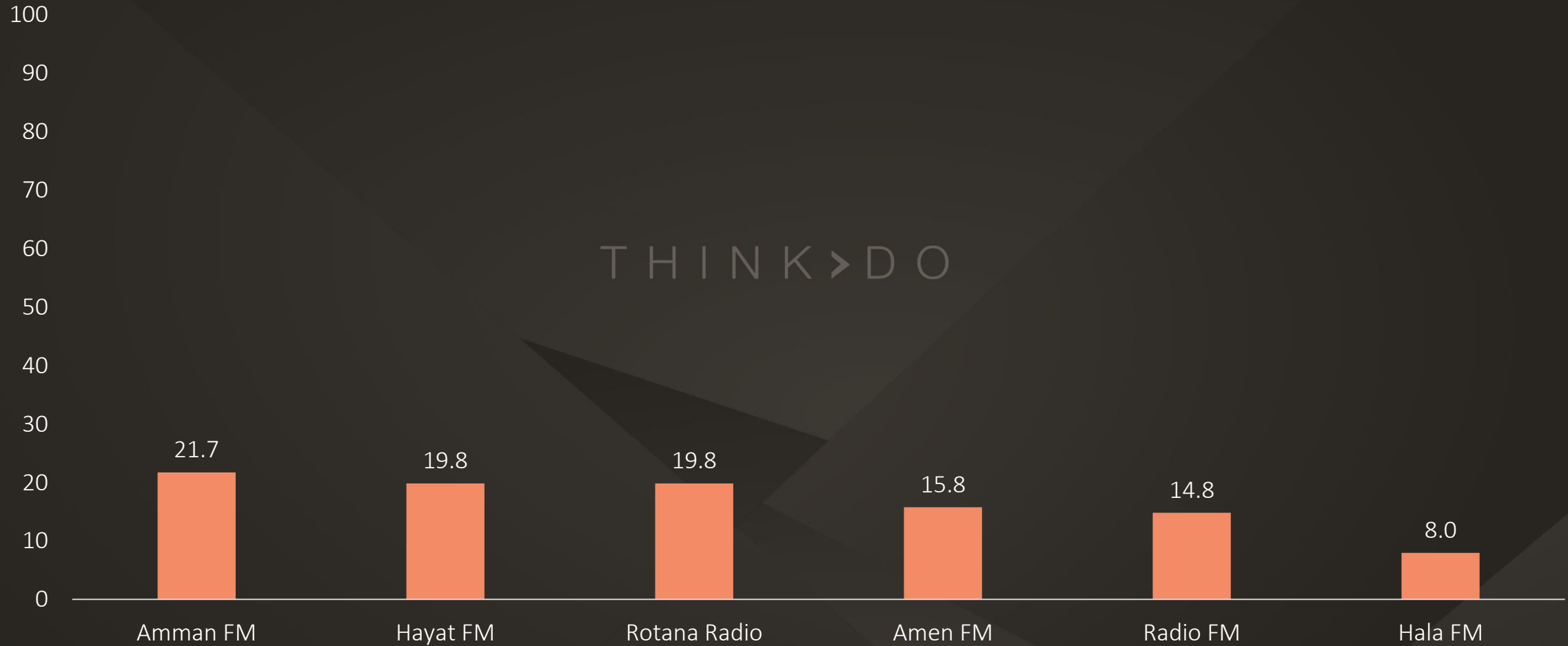

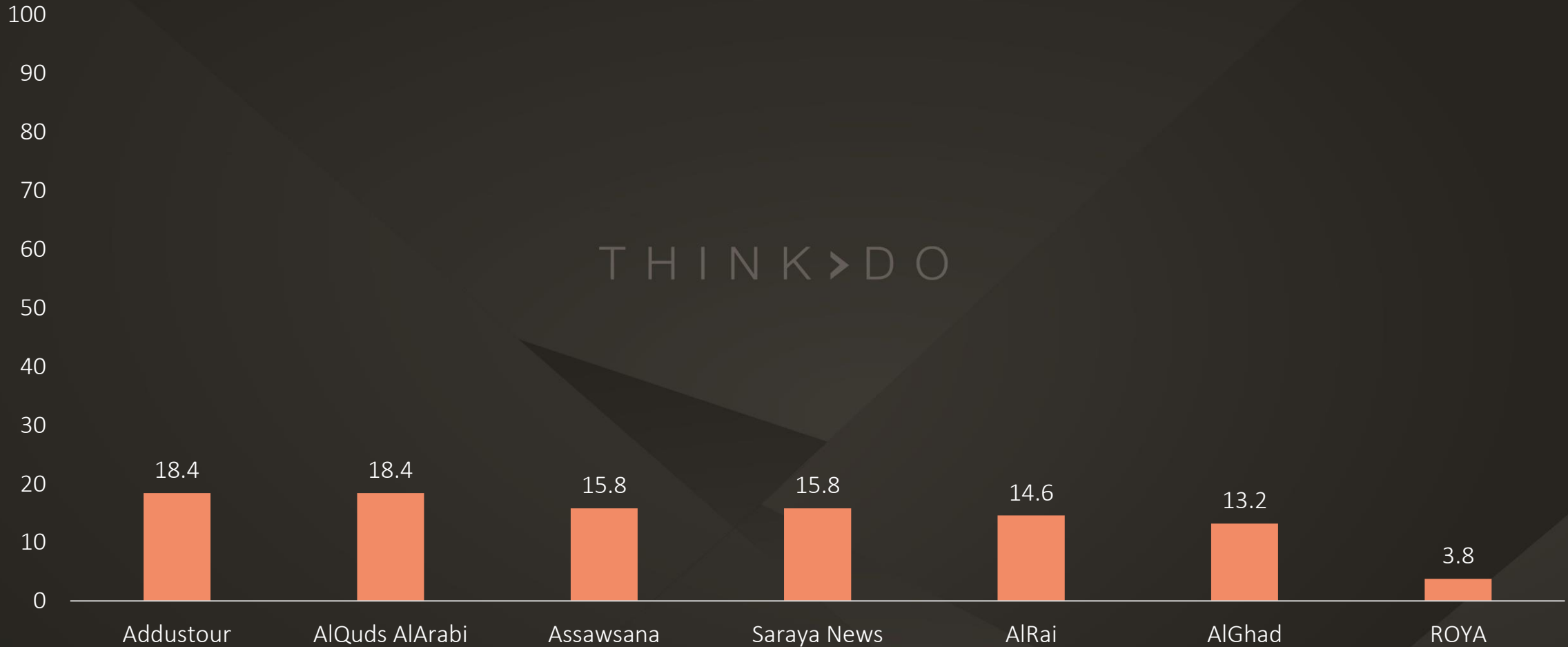

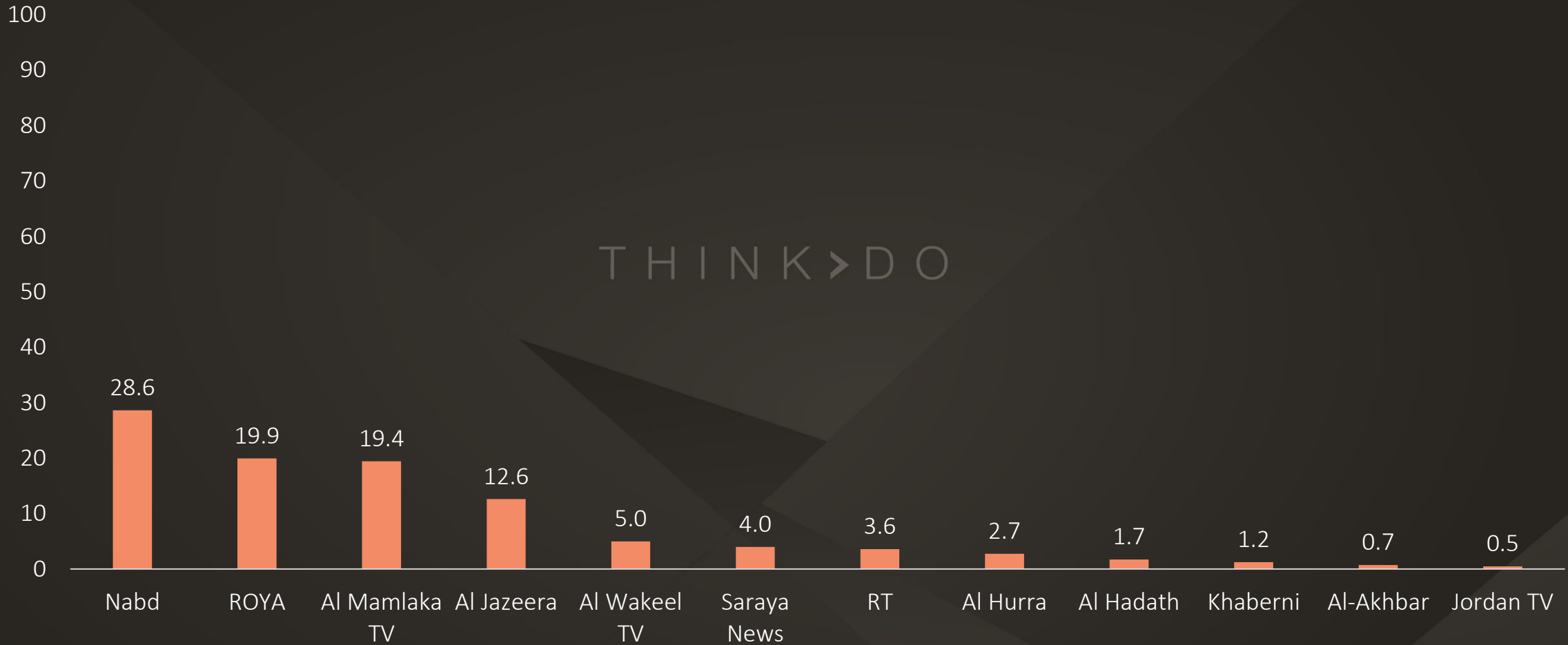

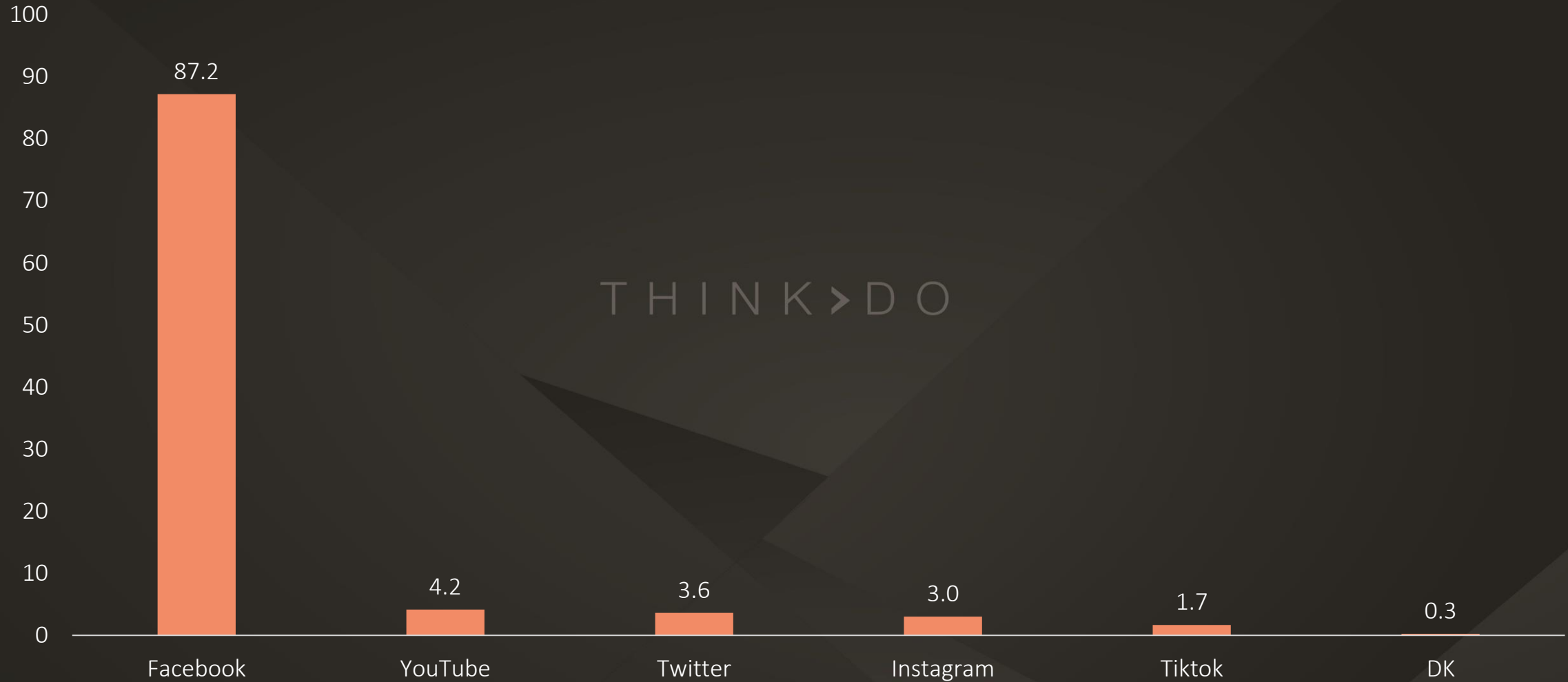

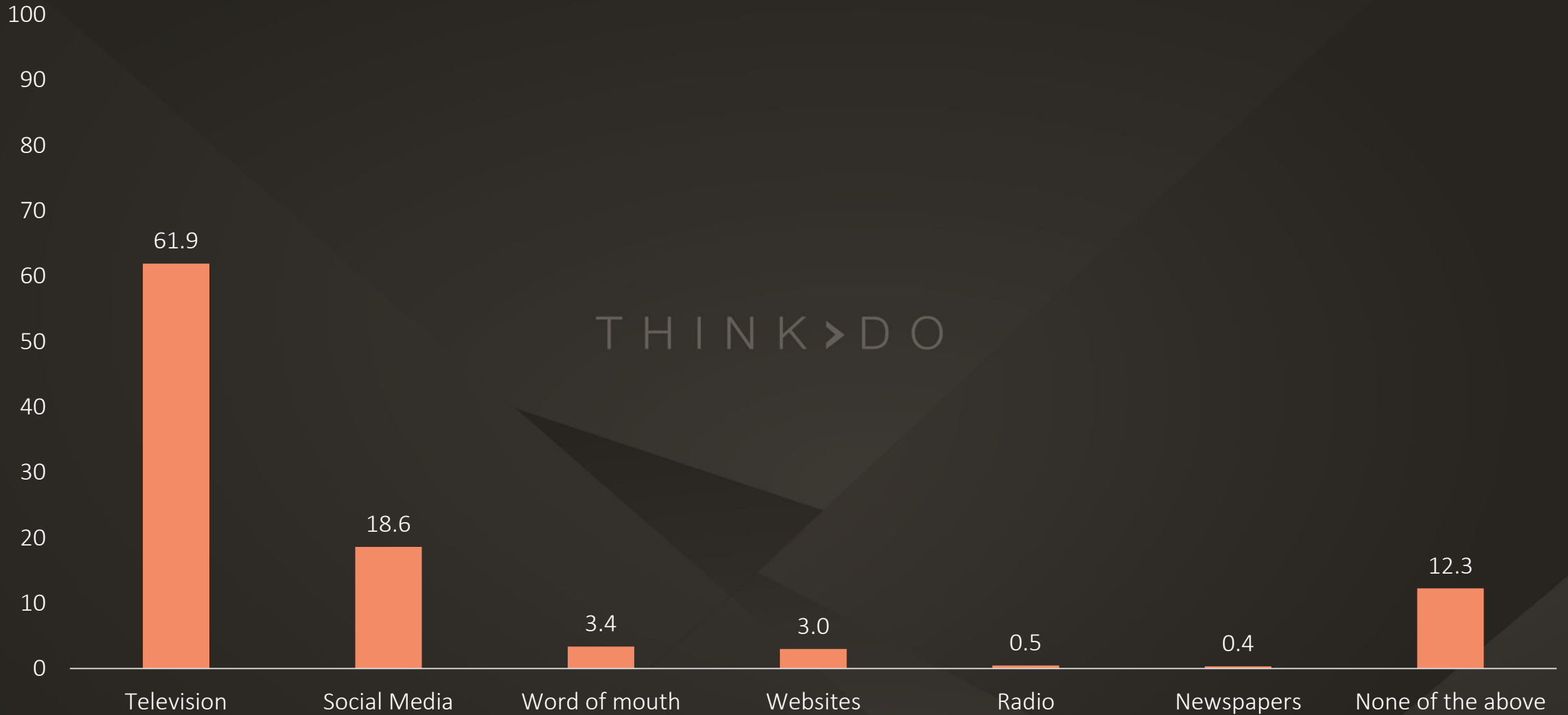


Choose which social media platform you use the most to obtain information about the conflict:

## What is the most trustworthy source of information on the crises for you



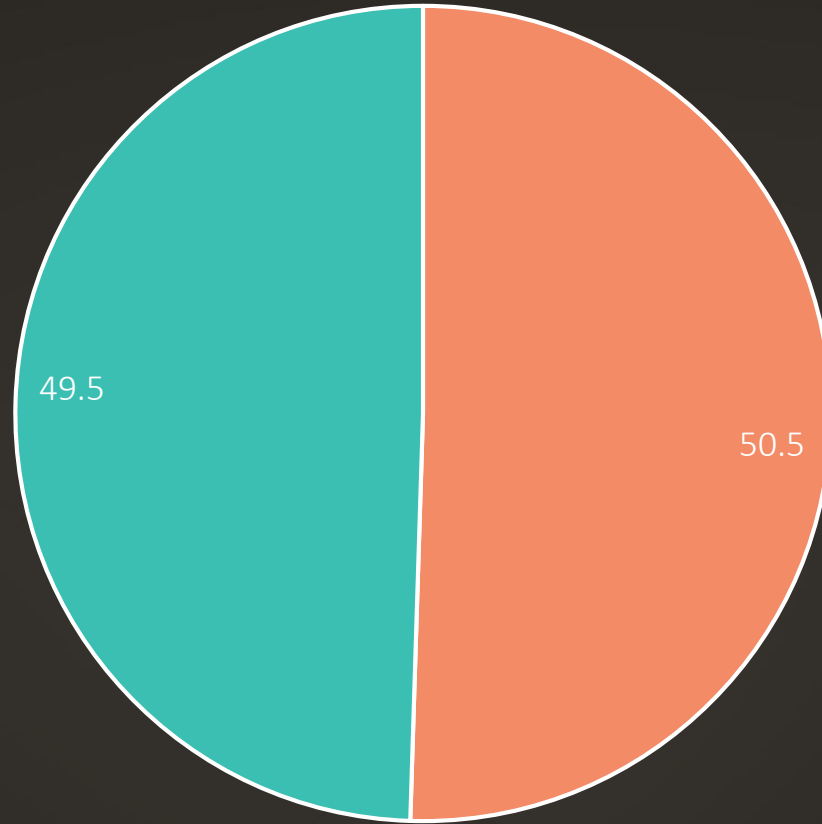

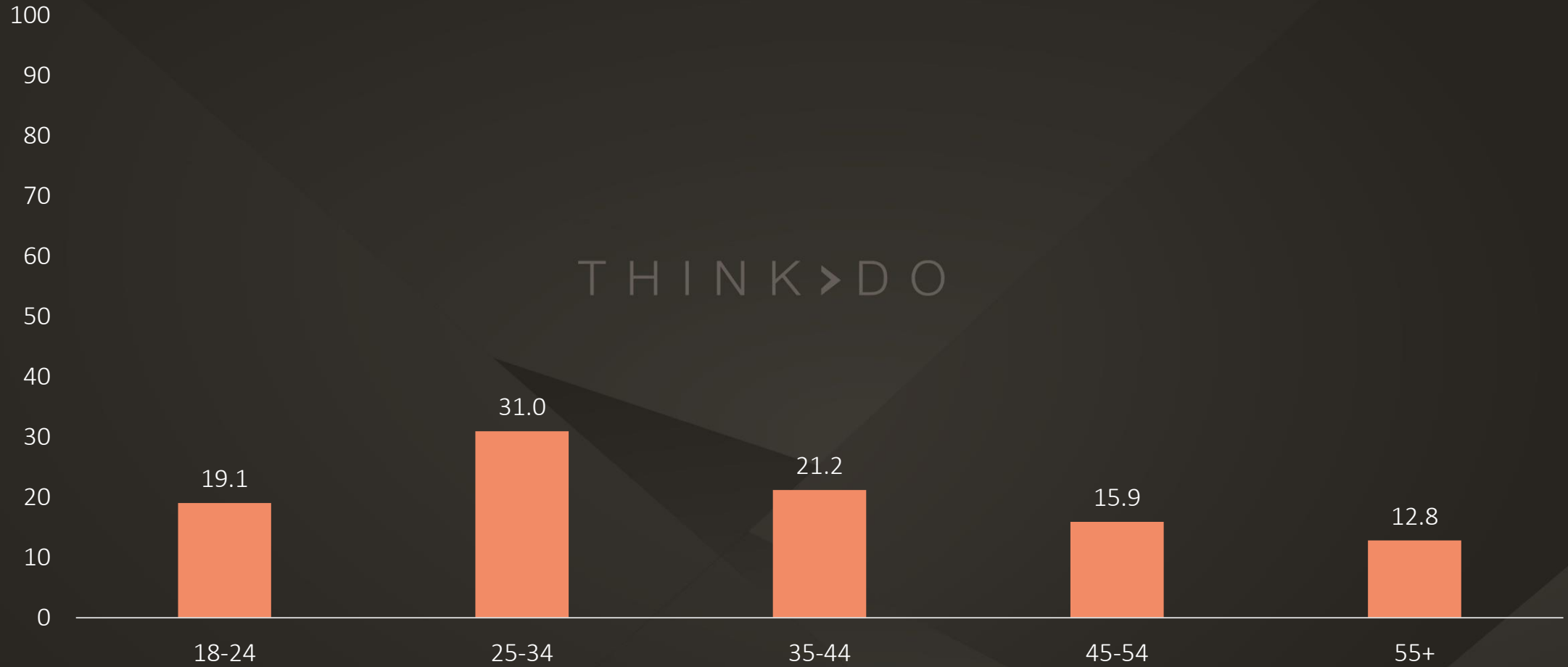

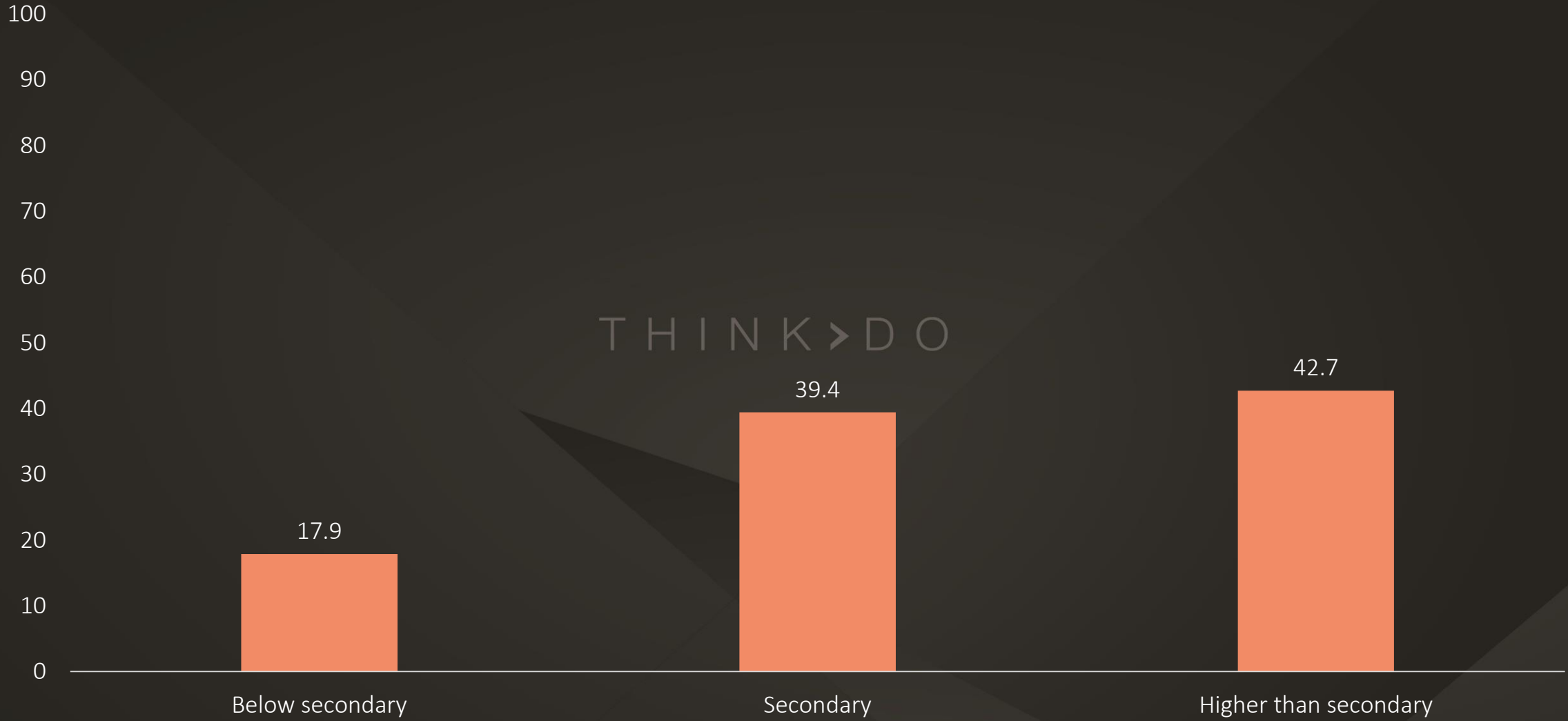

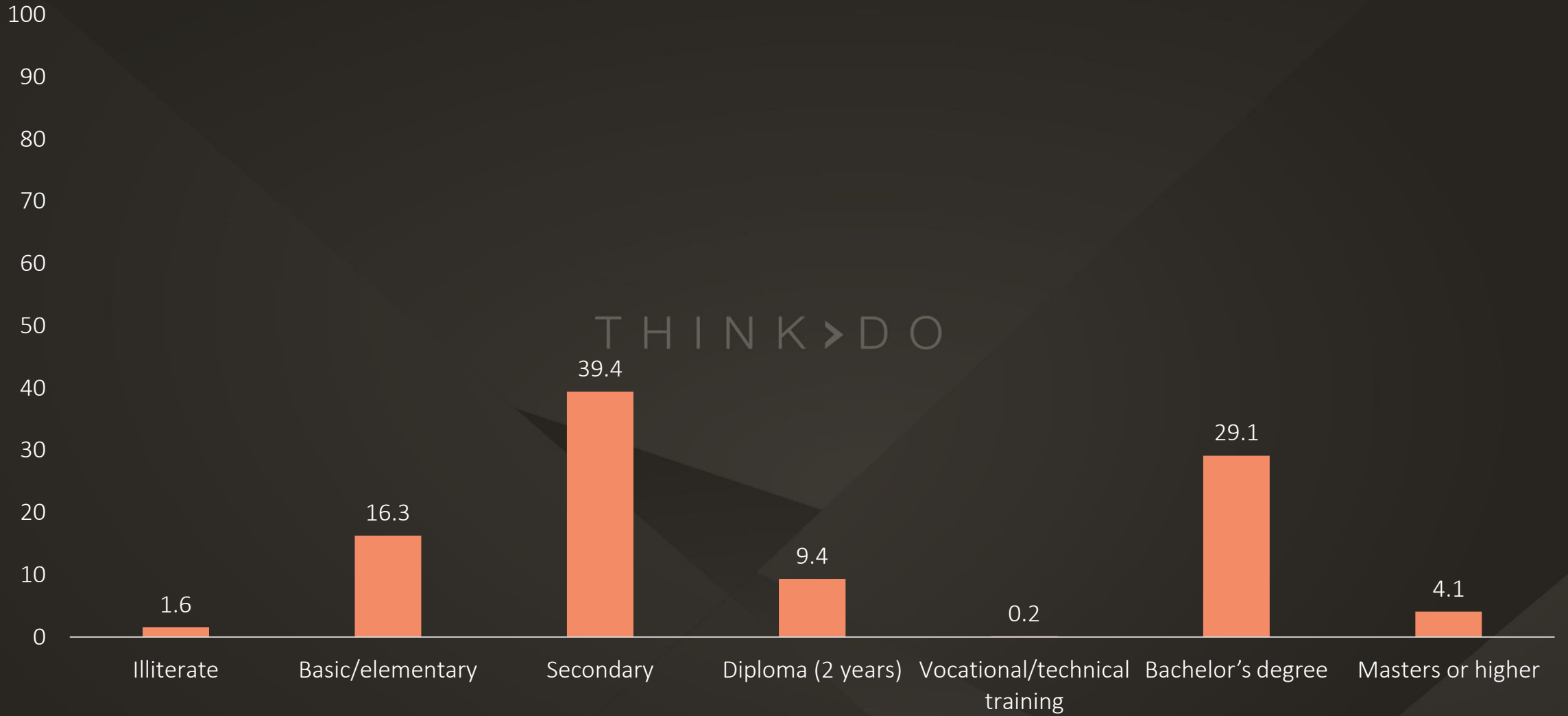

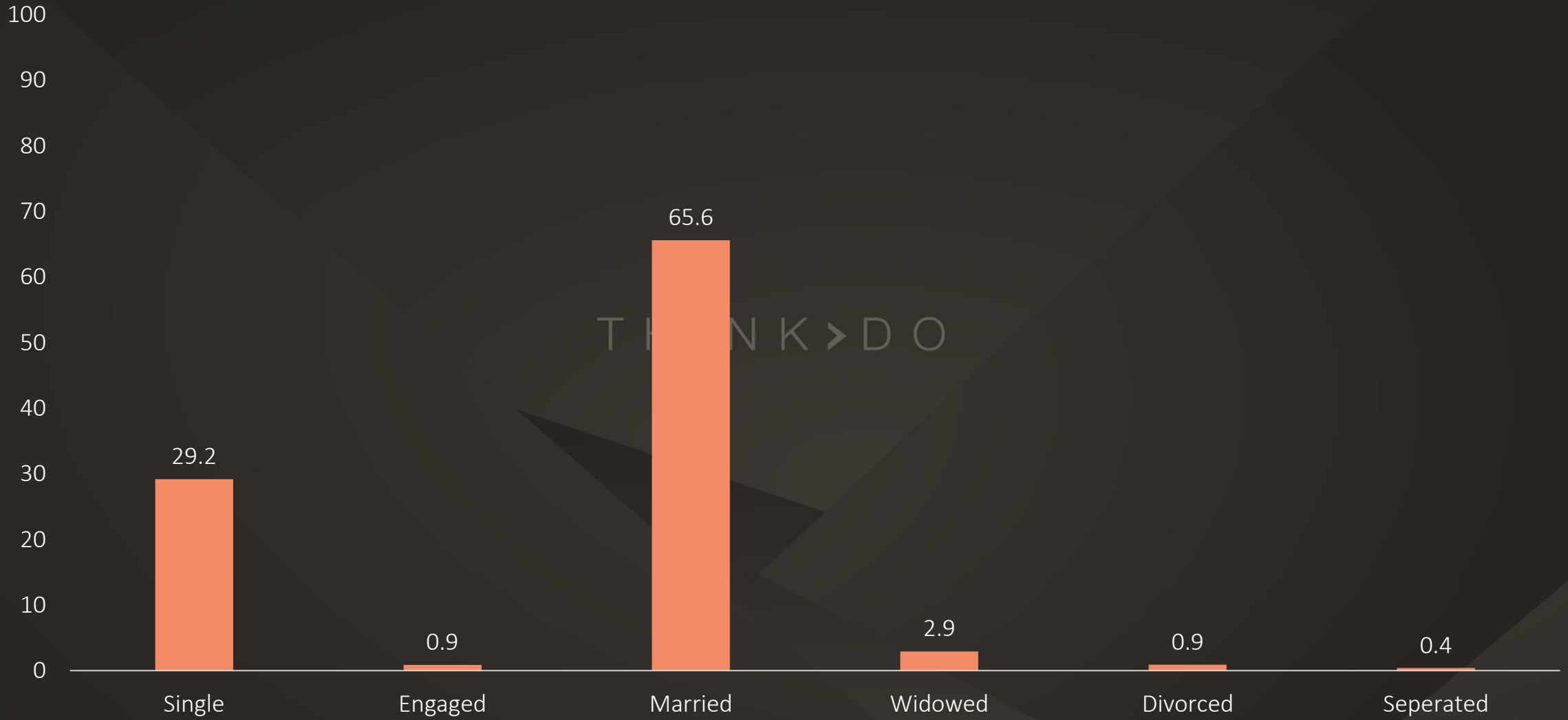
## Educational Level

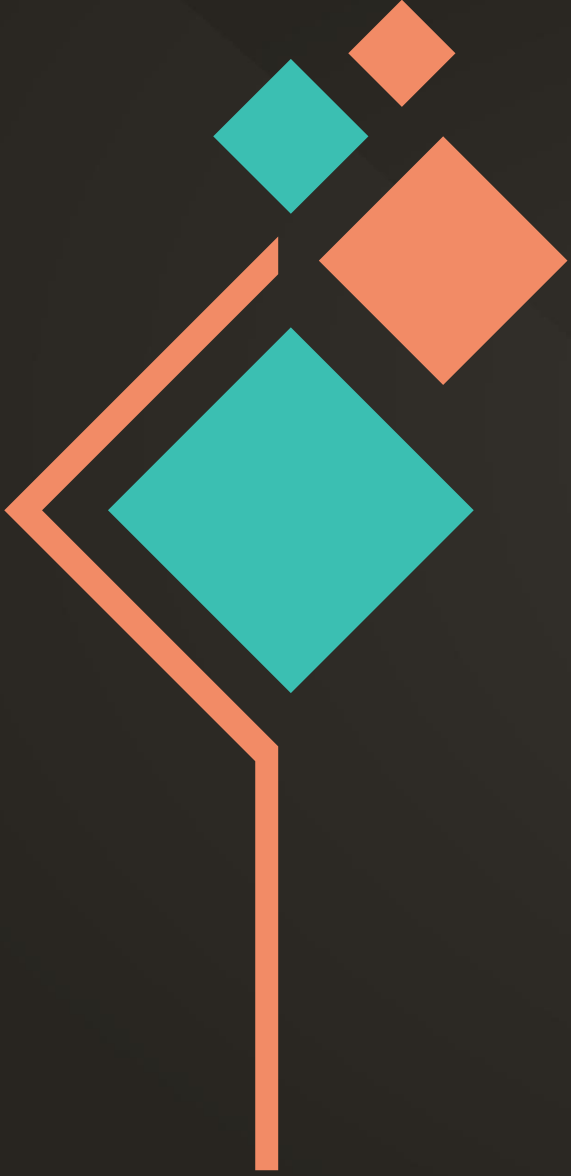


## Educational Level (Broken Down)
